WEDDING INFORMATION AND GUIDELINES

Congratulations on your decision to marry! We are glad you chose to celebrate your marriage and your faith in God with us here at Holy Rosary. We hope the following information will help your planning go smoothly. We also provide these guidelines so that you can help us maintain this church as a place of community prayer as well as an attractive place for worship of all kinds.

THESE REGULATIONS MUST BE FOLLOWED BY ALL WEDDING PARTIES.

1. Ribbons, bows, etc. may be used if they do not damage the pews.
2. Aisle runners are not permitted due to liability.
3. Nothing is to be thrown such as rice, birdseed, confetti, cut-up ribbon, paper, flower petals, etc. due to liability.
4. Immediately after the ceremony, please remove all decorations, empty corsage and flower boxes, garment bags, etc. Trash containers are located in the Community Room.
5. Please leave the Bridal Room and bathrooms clean.
6. Videotaping is permitted- the Priest or Deacon will direct the placement of the video camera at the rehearsal. Under no circumstance is any camera or photographer allowed in the Sanctuary.
7. No flash photography will be allowed during the ceremony except by a professional photographer.
8. No alcoholic beverages are to be consumed on the premises or prior to the wedding ceremony.
9. No smoking is allowed on the building premises.
10. We suggest that the receiving line be held at the reception.
11. Suggested stipend is \$150.00 to the presiding Priest or Deacon. Please make your checks payable directly to the Priest or Deacon.

12. Unity Candles are permitted. When purchasing your Unity Candle, please be sure to purchase non-drip candles. Flowers may be placed around the Unity Candle.
13. Two floral arrangements may be placed in the Sanctuary (one in front of the Ambo and one in front of the two candle stands). No flowers may be placed directly on the Altar. *We encourage and welcome the floral arrangements to remain for the weekend liturgies.*
14. The dress of the bride and bridesmaids must be modest. No bare shoulders may be exposed during the ceremony.

TIME OF WEDDINGS

Weekday: Check with Priest or Deacon

Saturday: 1:00PM; you must be out of the Church
no later than 2:45PM.

MARRIAGE LICENSE

Bring the entire marriage license envelope, along with the stipend for the Priest, musicians, and altar servers, to the parish secretary prior to the wedding rehearsal.
